

Kick Off Party

Supplies needed are highlighted in gray

HAVE A WATER HOSE, BUCKET OF HOT SOAPY WATER AND A RAG HANDY TO WIPE THINGS DOWN

HAVE A BUCKET OF WARM WATER FOR KIDS TO RINSE THEIR HANDS OR CANS OF SHAVE CREAM OFF WHEN THEY GET TO SLIMY

Itinerary and Supply List/Activity List – Week 1 – Kickoff Party

Basic Supply and Activity List

CAMERA – (Have someone take LOTS of pictures)

Whistle (A Must....they get excited and loud)

Megaphone (Optional)

Lots of Old Hand Towels or Rags (1 per person + a few extra) Even though you tell them to bring towels...they will forget

Large Trash Bags for parents to put on kids or seats

Scissors – Adult Scissors to cut holes trash bags- (To go on Kids)

Slime Prizes from Dollar Store – Jars of slime, flarp, etc.

Sharpee to write kids names on the slime prizes – They will pick up when time to go home.

Water Hoses- (Get Key to hydrant)

Run water hoses and have ready in case parents want to hose off kids before going home.

Plus all supplies listed under each game below (highlighted in gray)

Game One

Shave Cream Wars

Supply List :

HAVE A BUCKET OF WARM WATER FOR KIDS TO RINSE THEIR HANDS OR CANS OF SHAVE CREAM OFF WHEN THEY GET TO SLIMY

1 Can of Shave Cream Per Person (We used all brands and kinds and there were no problems- Try to get the sensitive type if possible)

1 Pair of Goggles per person – (If desired) No one used them for our event and all was well

1 old hand towel or rag per person in case they need them – (Give one to each child and have them stick them IN their shirt or IN their shorts so they stay clean...to use for eyes or hands)

Preparation:

Gather 1 Can of Shave Cream Per Person, one towel per person, one pair of goggles per person

Object: Kids will have a shave cream war.

The object of this battle is TO GET MESSY...not to avoid getting MESSY.

Messiest person gets a slime prize.

Note: Tell them not to wipe off the excess because we are going to use it for the next game.

Game Two

Shave Cream Man: Prize Awarded

Supply List:

2-3 Folding Tables...Depending on how many kids you have...they all have to be able to stand around the tables to reach the containers of paint

Paper or Plastic to cover the tables

Tape to secure the paper or plastic to the tables

Cans of Shave Cream

Jars of "Powdered" Tempera Paint – Various Colors

Large Plastic Containers with Lids

Large Stirring spoons

Slime Prize

Paper Plates

Plastic Spoons

Preparation:

Mix shave cream with different colors of "Powdered" tempera paint. (Use a stand Mixer if mixing large batches)

Place mixed paint in plastic containers with lids until time to use

Game Time

Open all the bowls of paint and set them around on the tables...you can have several bowls of the same colors setting around on the table in various areas. Just mix the colors so that there is every color on each side.

Object:

Using the shave cream that is on their bodies from the last game, the kids will decorate themselves. They will also use the colored shave cream that I have prepared on the paper plates. (Prize)

Game Three:

Whipped Cream Eating Contest – Prizes Awarded

Supply List:

Cans of Whipped Cream (1 Can Per 6 People) About 1 Cup per person...(Note: Test the portion sizes with the first can used and base portions accordingly) After preparing, I went along and added more to the 5th and 6th graders to make it more fair. Have a few extra cans just in case.
Large Paper Plates (You do not fill the entire plate...just the center area.
Slime Prizes for winners (Can have a prize for 1st and 2nd, 3rd and 4th, 5th and 6th if desired)

Preparation:

Gather Whipped Cream (1 Can per 6 People) + a few extra cans
Gather Paper Plates (1 Per Person)
Gather Prizes

Object:

Divide kids into groups... 1st & 2nd graders, 3rd & 4th graders and 5th & 6th graders.

Have the kids lay on their stomachs with hands behind their backs. One long row (Line up in order... 1st and 2nd graders...a leave a small space...2nd and 3rd graders...then leave a small space...5th and 6th graders.)

One person sprays whipped cream onto each plate while two or 3 others lay the plates in front of each person.

Before starting, add more whipped cream to the 5th and 6th graders plates...just for fun!

When the whistle blows, kids race to see who can eat all their whipped cream plus lick their plates clean...no hands allowed.

First one finished in each group will jump up onto their feet and yells done. Judge for that section will check plate...if licked clean the judge calls a winner...if not clean the judge says no and game continues.

Note: Have three judges available one for each group.

Game Four:

Cheeto Head - Prize awarded for the team captain of the winning team

Supplies:

1-2 Bag of Cheese Balls (Depending on how many kids you have)

Small Cups

SHAVE CREAM – 2 Cans

Orange Cones or Caution Tape (To mark the “Do Not Cross” line)

5 Folding “Team Captain: Chairs (More if you have a large group)

Preparation:

Fill small cups with cheese balls (1 cup per person)

Set up the 5 team captain chairs

Set up cones or a “do not cross” line with ribbon or caution tape...Approx 8 feet from the orange cones or tape.

Object:

- a. Select 5 Team Captains (Or more depending on number of kids attending)
- b. Have the team captains sit In the folding chairs
- c. Squirt a large pile of shave cream onto the team leaders head.
- d. Give each team member a cup full of cheese balls.
- e. Standing behind the line, members will throw their cheese balls at their team captain’s head...try to get as many cheese balls stuck in the whipped cream as possible.
- f. Play continues until all cheese balls are gone

Game 5

Game Five:

Gross Goo (Yuck)

Supplies:

Purchase 2 – 1 lb Packages of Yuck

(<http://www.recfx.com/> \$16.00 Per Package- Total \$32.00 - Will use for three different activities in the coming weeks)

Cattle Tank or Large Tank/Tub of some sort

Marbles

Water

Water Hose

Timer - Optional

Preparation:

24 Hours in advance...Pour Yuck into cattle tank, add 40 Gallons of Water and let it do its thing.

Dump Marbles into the tank

Let the kids sit get in the tank and search for marbles...set timer if desired

**NOTE: DO NOT THROW THE YUCK OUT WHEN
FINISHED...WATER CAN BE DRAINED BUT KEEP THE
YUCK...YOU CAN WASH OUT THE SLIME BUCKETS WHEN DONE
AND FILL WITH YUCK...DO NOT PUT LIDS ON BUCKETS...JUST
LEAVE OUTSIDE IN A COVERED AREA TO DRY OUT SOME.
WILL USE IT FOR TWO OTHER SLIME ACTIVITIES LATER ON**

Game 6

SLIME BUCKET – A BIG DEFINITE

SUPPLIES

5 GALLON BUCKETS OF SLIME – 1 BUCKET PER 7 KIDS

Wading Pool

Sand Pail with handle

Preparation:

Make Buckets of Slime (5 Gallon Buckets)

Instructions:

Fill 5 Gallon bucket half full of water

Add 5 lb bag of flour

Add Green Food Coloring (to color desired)

Add 1 Green Jello OR Green Kool-Aid (For scent) I used kool-aid

Stir Well

Add 1 large bottle of baby shampoo (no more tears) – OPTIONAL – I DID NOT USE BUT WILL TRY IT NEXT TIME

Add More water...up to about the $\frac{3}{4}$ level line

Add another 5 lbs of flour

Stir Well

I dipped the mixture into the stand mixer bowl and mixed thoroughly.

Dumped into another 5 gallon bucket and re-filled bowl again...repeating until all mixture was mixed well.

Gather Pail and Wading Pool

Object:

Pick Partner

Have child sit or stand in the pool... **We Stood (More Fun)**

DIP SAND PAIL IN BUCKET OF SLIME AND FILL

POUR sand pail of slime OVER TEAM MATES HEAD...Switch and repeat until all kids have been slimed

NOTE: IT WOULD BE LOTS OF FUN TO HAVE A CEMENT MIXER...JUST HAVE THE KIDS DUMP ALL THE INGREDIENTS IN THAT EVENING AND MIX...WOULD BE SUPER FUN!
