

Black

Red

Now remember Heaven is a perfect place isn't it? There is No sin in Heaven. So How do we get to Heaven if we are all sinners? There is only one way to get to Heaven and that is through Jesus Christ. Jesus went to the cross, and was punished for our sins. He paid for our sins. Jesus gave us a special gift didn't He? When Jesus hung on the cross, He gave His own blood so that we might be saved. So let's put our red square on because that means Jesus' blood.

White

Now how do we get to Heaven? How do we accept this wonderful gift that Jesus has given to us? All we have to do is ask Jesus to come into our hearts and be our Lord and Savior and to forgive us of our sins, and then will God forgive us? Yes! Will our sins be washed away? YES. So let's put our white square on next because white stands for our white hearts. When God washes away our sin, our hearts aren't black anymore, they are white.

Green:

Green represents growth. When you look outside at the trees, the grass and the flowers, those things all grow and they are all green. When we accept Jesus, our faith begins to grow. We read our Bibles more, we go to church and learn about Jesus and we grow in our faith, so let's put our

green square on our cross to represent our growth in Christ.

Blue

After we accept Jesus as our Lord and Savior, we go in front of the church and we are baptized in water. We are placed under the water and brought back up again. This means that we want everyone to know of our decision to accept Jesus. When we are placed under the water, it is just like Jesus when he was placed in the tomb. He died, was buried and rose again. And when the pastor brings us back up out of the water, we are like Jesus when He rose from the tomb. We are saying goodbye to our old sinful life and hello to a new life with Jesus. So let's put our blue square on our cross next to represent our baptism.

Purple


