Oil Fears Water

1 Clear Jar with a lid
1 cup water—Living Water
1/3 cup oil—Sin
1 egg—God—The Trinity



WATER - REPRESENTS LIVING WATER

Pour the water into your jar. Jeremiah 17:13 the Bible refers to Jesus as The Spring of living water.

"Those who turn away from you will be written in the dust because they have forsaken the Lord, the SPRING OF LIVING WATER".

So for this lesson, the water that we have right here...is Living Water...it Represents Jesus!

OIL—REPRESENTS SIN

So, what separates us from God? What causes us to "turn away" as it says in Jeremiah 17:13? Sin! Sin separates us from God. When we tell a lie, that's a sin...and it separates us from God. When we disobey our parents or our teachers...that's a sin...and it separates us from God. Even a bad thought about someone else...is a sin...and it separates us from God.

So, this oil that we have right here...represents Sin.

Before we add it to our jar, let's touch it...how does is feel? Slimy, Greasy, Messy...just like sin.

The Bible tells us this in 1 John 3:8 "The one who does what is sinful is of the devil, because the devil has been sinning from the beginning. The reason the Son of God appeared was to destroy the devil's work.

So when we sin...what does it cause? Separation from God.

Add the oil to the water.

Look at that...the oil and water have separated from each other.

The oil is actually repelling the water. Which means that it is refusing to mix with the water.

Did you know that there is a name for that? It's called hydrophobic or "water fearing."

The oil...fears the water so it clings tightly together to repel the water. Do you think that Satan fears God?

Absolutely!

When we sin...it separates us from God. But remember...the oil "fears" the water.

So sin fears the living water...Satan fears Jesus!

Egg Represents the Trinity

So let's look at our last item...an egg. What do you think this egg represents? It represents God...the Trinity. God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit.

The shell represents God the Father, the white represents God the Son, the yellow or yoke represents God the Holy Spirit—All separate...but all one! All God!

So if sin fears the living water...if Satan Fears God

And if sin separates us from the living water...if sin separates us from God What do you think will happen when we add God? (Hold up the egg)

"God the Father" (crack the egg open)

God the Son (separate the white...letting it drip into the jar)

God the Holy Spirit (drop the yoke into the jar)

Put the lid on the jar and give it a good shake.

Look...the oil has disappeared.

When we ask God to forgive us of our sins...and to come into our hearts and be our Lord and Savior...He will forgive us of our sins...and He will come into our hearts and be our Lord and Savior.

And then where will we go when we die? To heaven...and we see a reminder right here...with this white puffy cloud of foam that is left on the top of our water.
