



Black is for the sins we made: Our sins darken our hearts and cause us to live in darkness. **Black** also reminds us of the dark tomb where Jesus was placed. Jesus had to die so that we might live forever. Acts 26:17-18

Red is for the blood He gave: - Jesus died on the cross for each one of us...when He died on the cross, His blood was the sacrifice that was required to cover our sins. He willingly died for each one of us because He **LOVES** us so much. John 1:7

Purple is for the hours of sorrow:
Purple is the color of royalty. It reminds us that Jesus is our King. It also reminds us of the sadness that all of His friends felt when He died upon the cross.
Mark 15:17

White is for the grace He gave. - Our sins can be forgiven and our hearts can be made white as snow when we believe in Jesus, when we ask Him to forgive our sins and when we ask Him to come into our hearts...and be our Lord and Savior. Isaiah 1:18

Orange is for the edge of night: When we ask Jesus to come into our hearts and be our Lord and Savior. The Holy Spirit will come and live inside of us... the Holy Spirit's **fire** will burn within us and leads us. Psalm 78:14

Green is for our growth in Christ: When we read God's Word and we hide His words in our hearts...when we learn to trust in Him more and more, Our faith will grow and grow and grow. Psalms 119:105

Blue is for the blue waters of Baptism: When we are baptized, we are showing others that we are followers of Christ. And that we are VERY proud of our new life in Christ. Mark 16:16

Yellow is for the sun so bright: Like a new sunrise, Jesus rose from the grave on Easter morning...He is **ALIVE**...and He lives inside of each one of those who chooses to follow Him. 1 Thessalonians 4:14
