

THE FREE GIFT OF SALVATION

Fact: The Bible tells us that we are ALL sinners. We have ALL done things that separate us from God.
"For ALL have sinned, and fall short of the glory of God". Romans 3:23

Fact: Sin Separates us from God. It breaks our communion with Him.

Fact: God loves us but He hates the sin in our lives.

Fact: The punishment for sin is death. Not just physical death but eternal death...
a separation from God forever.

"For the wages of sin is death..." Romans 6:23

Fact: We don't have to be separated from God.

Fact: Because God loves us, and because He doesn't want to be separated from us, He provided
His own sacrifice. That sacrifice was Jesus. God's one and only son.

Fact: Jesus died on the cross to pay the price for our sins.

Fact: Our lives were atoned (amended for) by the shedding of Jesus' blood.

"...it is the blood that makes atonement for one's life." Leviticus 17:11

Why would God Sacrifice His own son? Because He loves us that much!

"But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.
Romans 5:8

Fact: Because of Jesus' great sacrifice, we are offered a FREE gift. It's the Gift of Salvation...
the gift of forgiveness.

Fact: God offers us a new life. A SWEET life! A life with Him throughout all of eternity!

Fact: God's gift of Salvation (forgiveness) is not something that we have earned...
it's not something that we deserve. It's a gift that costs us nothing but was paid for...at a very high cost.

Fact: We can choose God's gift...or we can refuse it. We have a choice.

"But the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord". Romans 6:23

Fact: There is nothing that we have ever done...or anything that we will ever do that God can't forgive.

Fact: All sin; no matter how large or small (you feel it is) is the same to God...it is SIN...and it separates you
from God.

Jesus Died, He was buried, and He rose again. His work has been completed...now it's our turn!

Fact: We can accept the FREE gift of Salvation (forgiveness) and live a life with God. Or, we can reject God's
gift and live a life of separation.

What will you choose? If you choose a life of forgiveness, simply lift your prayers to God.

God hears, He forgives, He saves!

"If you declare with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the
dead, you will be saved. Romans 10:9
